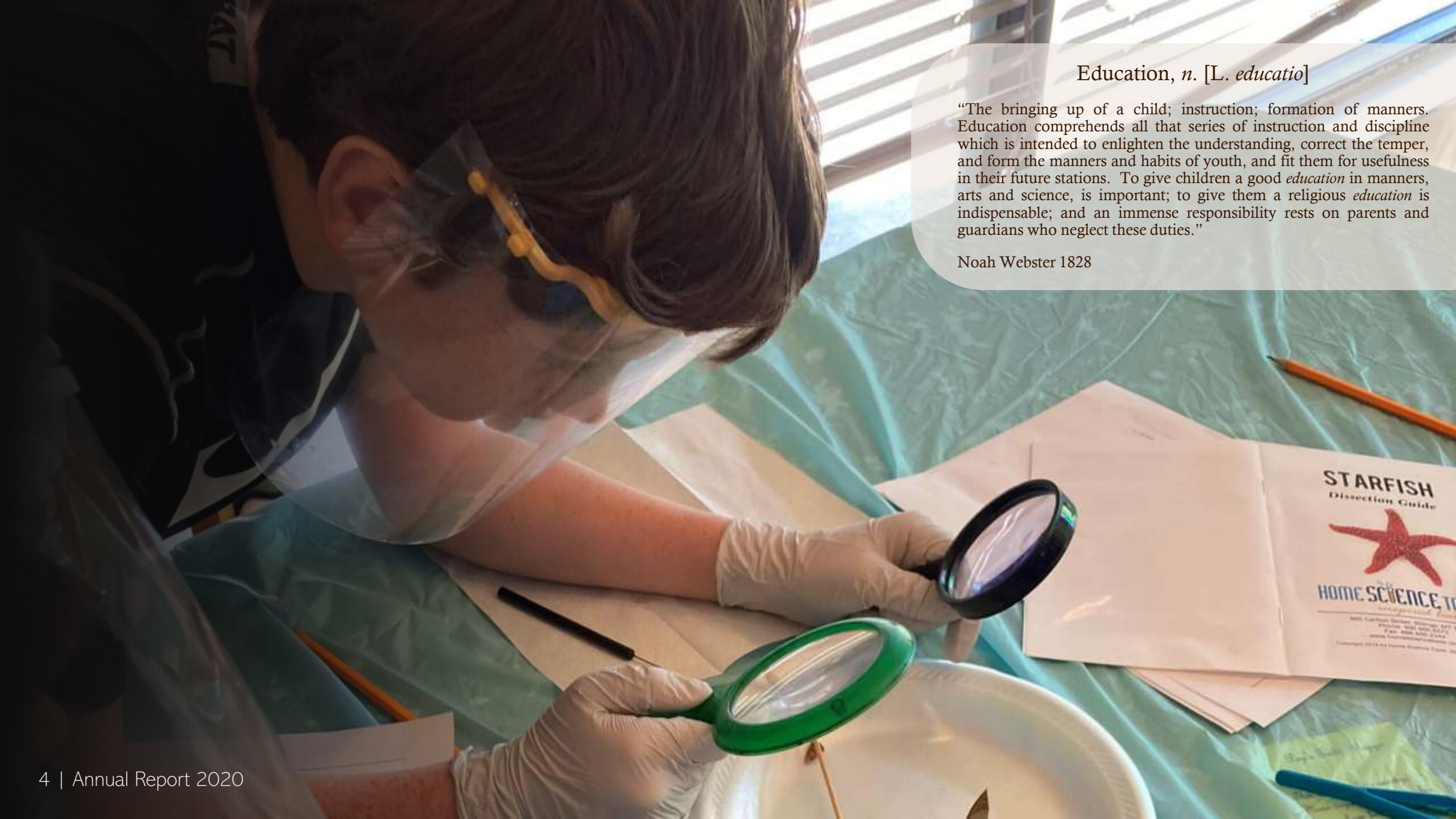

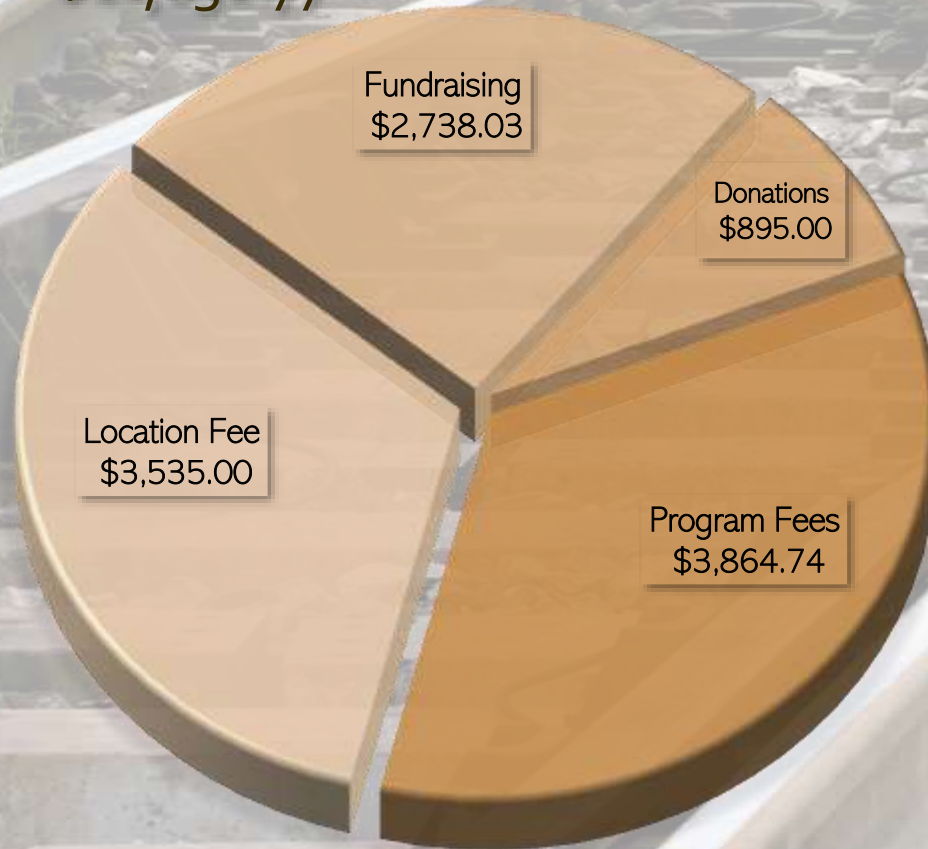

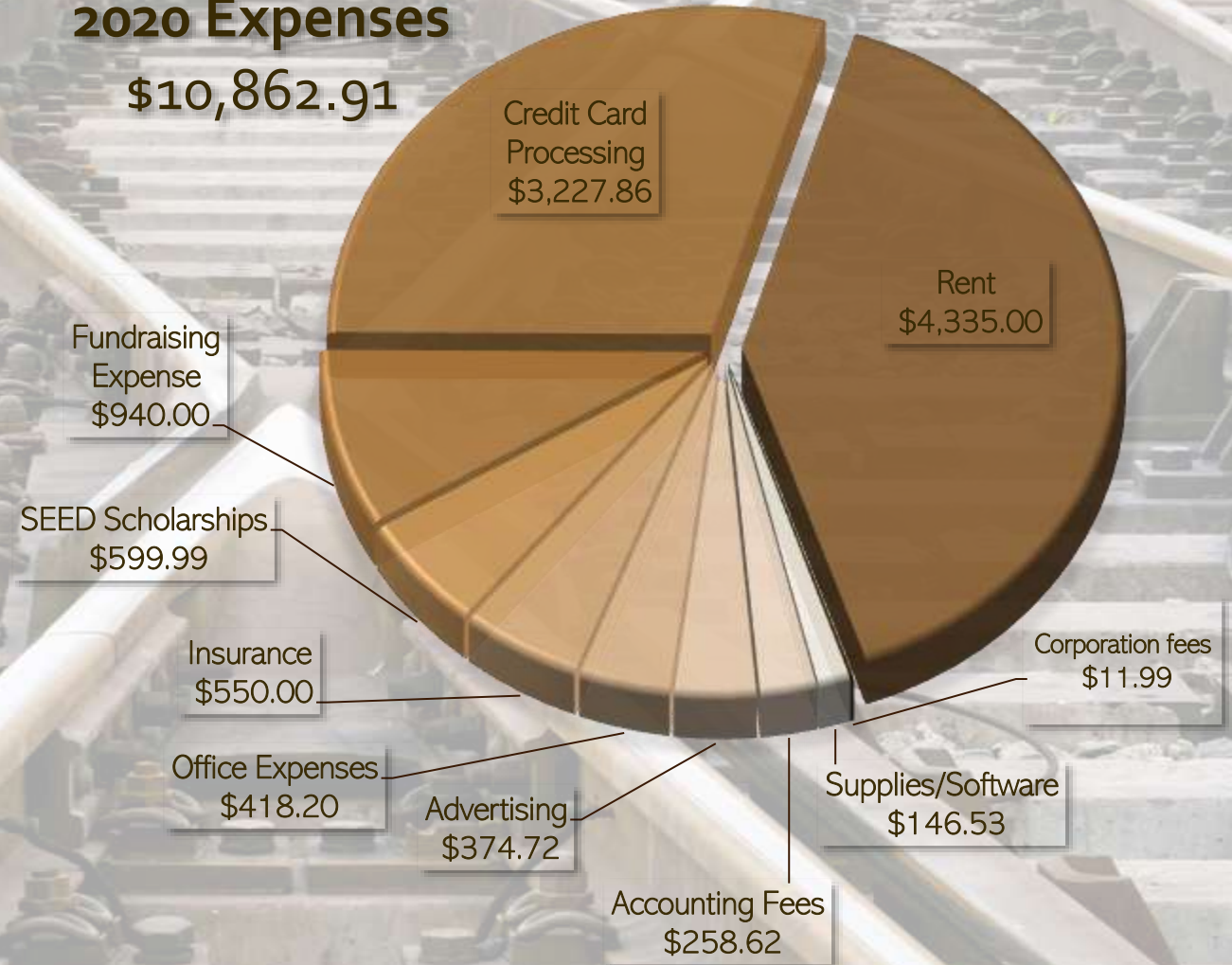
2020 Revenue


